OLD BUSINESS

1. Bob Markunis continues to book visits at Magnolia Heights, Benchmark Senior Living, Atria and the Franklin Rehabilitation Center on Chestnut Street. Magnolia Heights visits are the 2nd Monday of the month at 10:00 and Franklin Rehab visits are every third Saturday of the month at 2:00. Atria visits are luncheon events at 11:30 on the first Saturday of the month each month. Benchmark Senior Living (on Grove Street) sessions are scheduled the last Thursday of every month at 1:30. The bricks will display the honorees name and branch of service. The honoree can be someone living or deceased and they do not need to be from Franklin. NEW BUSINESS

1. Raffle – Raffle was held – Congratulations to all winners! Dave Labonte was the winner of the prize for most tickets sold!
2. The Strategic Committee reported on the Strategic Plan and have identified 6 areas of focus for the post: 1) Maintain 100% Renewal, 2) Increasing our operating budget, 3) Adding a Post Quartermaster, 4) Re-evaluate and locate a permanent facility, 5) improve communications with membership, and 6) be more visible and active in local events.



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3. Wreaths Across America event was very successful. On January 11th there is a need for volunteers to pick up the wreaths in Bourne. This is at 12:00. We can discuss this at the next meeting.
4. Next year the post will be 100 years old – Suggest we think about a good way to celebrate and make the post more visible – Perhaps attend the Harvest Festival? It was agreed that we should renew our membership in the Downtown Partnership and perhaps get an American Legion pop-up tent to use for these events? And should we have a joint event with the Wrentham post? It was suggested that a committee be formed to plan events for the 100 year anniversary – volunteers for this: Steve S. (leading), John M., Dave L. Dick Hynes, Kim.
5. Brockton VA – It was agreed that the event scheduled for December will need to be postponed due to impending bad weather. This will be re-scheduled to after the holidays,
6. The Post Quartermaster role was discussed and Dave Labonte was nominated and agreed to accept this role. Dave donated his raffle ticket selling prize to a post clothing fund and several other members also donated funds at the meeting for this effort. Thanks to all those who made a generous donation!
7. It was agreed that we should hold a 50/50 at each meeting.
8. It was agreed that we should get an American Legion plaque for George Ferguson's gravesite. This will be ordered from Flag and Emblem.

11. Poker tournaments - This was approved and the committee is proceeding with the paperwork. Permit has been obtained. Next item is to schedule dates for the tournaments.
