- 3. The Boston Symphony will host an "Afternoon of Brass" on May 27 and 28. John Hefele will send an email regarding this event
- 4. The finance officer's report was given. The current balance is \$3,742.82. The finance officer said he will continue multiple subscriptions to military magazines. One renewal was paid twice and monies will be returned to the post. The report was accepted and is posted on our website.
